

## **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Membership European Society of Oncologic Imaging (ESOI)

### **1. SOCIETY STATUTES**

With the membership application/renewal, the ESOI statutes are considered as accepted.

### **2. ACQUISITION OF MEMBERSHIP**

Applications for full, associate, resident or corporate membership shall be done online via the appropriate application form. After successfully submitting your application and proceeding with the payment, ESOI will welcome you as a new member of its society. ESOI membership is valid for the current calendar year. ESOI membership is awarded by the Executive Committee and may be refused without giving reason. ESOI members are asked to actively renew their membership each year by completing the necessary form.

### **3. MEMBERSHIP TYPES**

#### **Full Members**

shall be board certified radiologists, physicians or scientists with special interest and special experience in oncologic imaging.

#### **Associate Members**

shall be radiologists, physicians or scientists active in fields related to oncologic imaging or persons nominated by or on behalf of non-medical organisations.

#### **Resident Members**

shall be residents (young radiologists, physicians or scientists in training) with special interest in oncologic imaging. The age limit for an application as resident is set at 35 years (incl. the age of 35). Residents have to send or email a letter written on official hospital letter paper and signed by the head of department, confirming their status as such within 5 working days after submitting the membership application to the ESOI Office (office@esoi-society.org). In case this confirmation is not received, the membership fee will be automatically adjusted to a full membership fee.

#### **Corporate Members**

shall be enterprises and other organisations interested in the activities and aims of the society and providing financial support to the society. Corporate Members shall nominate one representative who will act as contact person for all membership related correspondence and who may participate in the General Assembly.

### **4. MEMBERSHIP FEE**

The membership fees are set by decision in the General Assembly. By automatic renewal the applicable membership fee agreed upon will be charged.

### **5. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MEMBERS**

All members of the Society shall be entitled to attend all meetings of the Society and to make appropriate use of its facilities.

Only full members in good standing having paid their membership fees and all arrears shall have a vote in the General Assembly and shall be entitled to stand for office.

All members shall be obliged to further the interests of the Society to the best of their abilities and to refrain from any action which might harm the reputation or the purpose of the Society. Members shall observe the Statutes of the Society and the resolutions of its organs.

## **6. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

Membership shall terminate through death – in the case of legal persons through loss of legal personality or bankruptcy - as well as through voluntary resignation, cancellation or expulsion.

**Voluntary resignation** shall only be possible effective with the end of a calendar year. Voluntary resignation has to be notified to the President-Elect in writing at least one month prior to the end of the calendar year. In case of late notification, it shall become effective only at the next withdrawal date.

**Cancellation of membership** will be effected by the Executive Committee if a member is in arrears with the payment of membership fees for more than six months despite two reminders. Cancellation of membership does not remove the obligation to pay the outstanding membership fees.

**The expulsion of a member** from the Society may be decided by the Executive Committee on the grounds of serious breach of the duties of a member or on the grounds of dishonorable behavior. Appeal to the General Assembly against exclusion shall be possible within two weeks after receipt of the written notification of expulsion. The membership rights and duties shall be suspended until a decision is taken by the General Assembly.

## **7. DEADLINE**

The membership application for ESOI membership will be open until December 20 of the current year. After this date, ESOI membership applications will no longer be accepted for the current year.

## **8. PERSONAL DATA**

You hereby accept the terms and conditions and statutes of ESOI and agree that your personal data, consisting of full name, profession, address (institution, hospital, department, home address) and email address may be disclosed to ESOI sponsors. You acknowledge that your personal data may be used to provide you with information relating to the field of oncological imaging and radiology, as well as information on scientific events. You also agree that ESOI is entitled to send emails to you, containing important information, on behalf of industry partners.
