

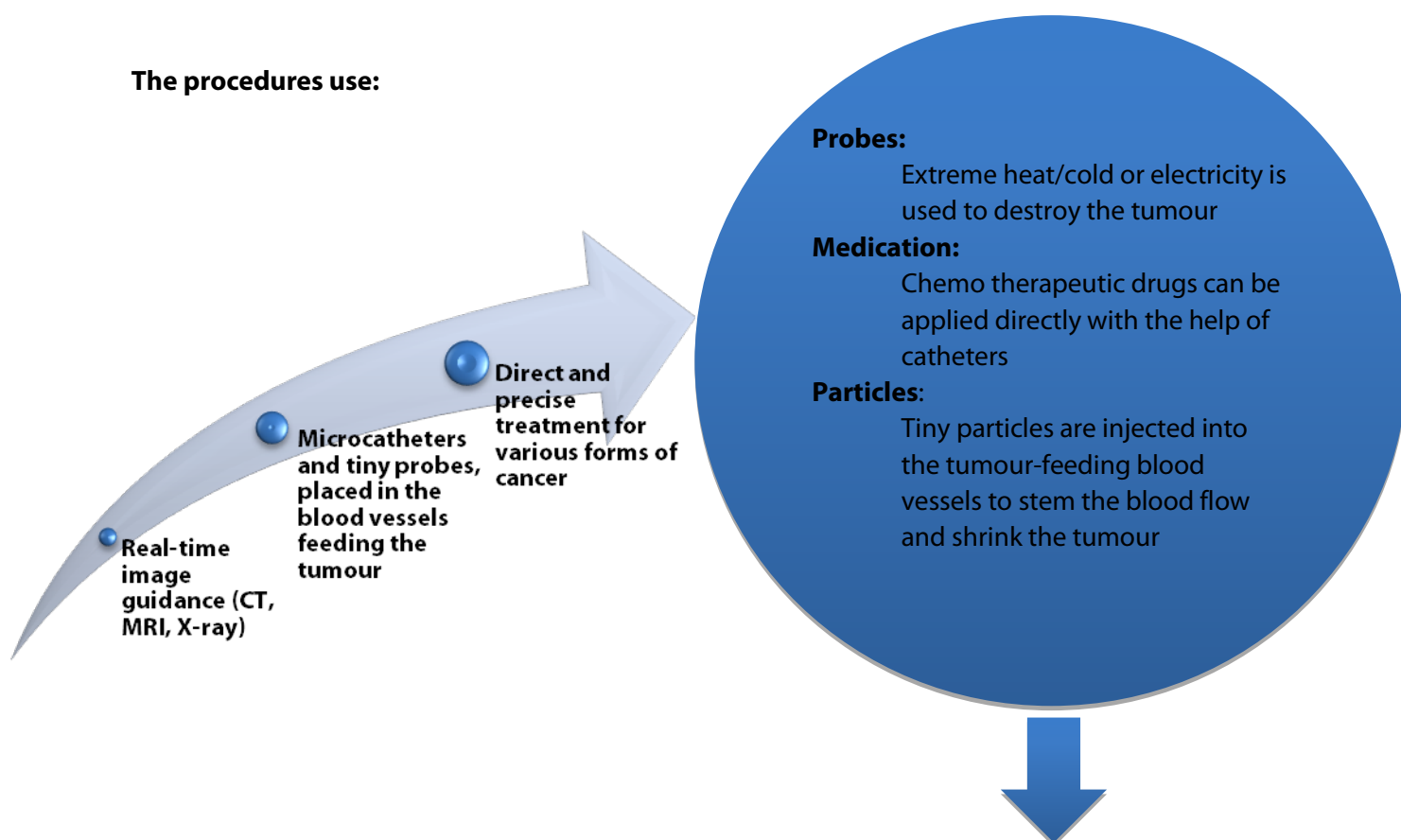


## MINIMALLY INVASIVE TREATMENT OPTIONS FOR CANCER

- Fewer side effects than with systemic treatment
